The mission of Leadership Portage County is to provide unique insights into Portage County; to explore and develop various styles, theories, and examples of leadership; to provide opportunities to build relationships and networks; and to serve as a catalyst for volunteerism and positive change in Portage County.

About the Program _____

Leadership Portage County is a nine-month experience designed to develop active and influential leaders with the appropriate knowledge to address important issues facing Portage County. Participants are engaged in an exploration of the region to gain a deep understanding of the county's opportunities and challenges. These experiential learning opportunities also provide professional development to assist participants in building their personal leadership skills.

The program begins in September with a class dinner followed by a two-day retreat. It continues through May with eight one-day sessions, ending with graduation in May. The sessions are facilitated by leaders in their field who cover topics related to the day's theme.
